


Red=share of national population living in metropolitan areas

# GDP and population in metropolitan areas (as share of national value)







### Administrative fragmentation of metropolitan areas


#### Index of municipal fragmentation in metropolitan areas in the OECD, 2012





#### **Good governance for metro areas**


- Fragmentation of a metropolitan area into too many municipalities causes coordination problems that reduce per capita GDP growth and productivity
  - A doubling of the number of municipalities per 100,000 inhabitants reduces productivity by 6%

- Number of municipalities in 2014-15




### Recent or on-going policies:

- Finland (gradual, on-going)
- Luxembourg (gradual, on-going)
- Netherlands (gradual, on-going)



### Metropolitan authorities are a solution to the problem of administrative fragmentation


- Negative impact of fragmentation can be reduced metropolitan authorities that coordinate policies
- Metropolitan authorities are common throughout the OECD
- In most countries, they have less power than in Italy
- Productivity is higher in metropolitan areas that have metropolitan authorities!





### Metropolitan governance reforms since 1951


#### Number of authorities created or reformed in the OECD by decade







